Presentations:

Kathy Nyland gave a presentation on the newly-launched Community Resource Hub, which aims to make the City's online content more easily accessible. Eric Tweit of Seattle Department of Transportation provided an update on the Madison Street Bus Rapid Transit project (RapidRide G Line), from Downtown Seattle to Madison Valley via First Hill. The move will increase capacity and efficiency and serve underserved neighborhoods (especially the north of the Central Area). Construction is scheduled for 2019 through late 2020 and will include extensive repaving of Madison and Spring.
