Jason Huff with the City of Seattle's Department of Arts & Culture presented on the city's art programming, including the "1% for Art" public arts program, and plans for art installations in the new Waterfront Park.

Leigh ceded the program to treasurer Linda Mitchell to run elections. The positions of president and secretary were up for elections. Leigh Valentine and Ben Anderstone ran for re-election to those two positions. There were no nominations from the floor, the two were elected unanimously.
