Angela Brady, Deputy Director for the Office of the Waterfront, presented an update on the project, including roads and pedestrian access, new beaches, the Promenade, and other connections to Pike Place Market. She discussed construction staging and timing of the project that will start when Viaduct demolition is completed in the Fall.
